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HOLY DAYS vs. HOLIDAYS

This calendar is presented as God established it in the Torah, with the addition of the *feast of dedication* 'Chanukah' which Jesus observed. Also added is the 3 key times of Jesus' crucifixion, resurrection, and ascension on the correct days.

Since the Jew's Rabbinite-Babylonian lunar calendar and Roman Julian calendar has created both confusion and delusion in view of our Creator's simple but accurate measure of time, one needs to consider the historic times of Christ's week of suffering, death, resurrection, and ascension. From Figure 2 (*Our Creator's Solar Calendar*, page 85), here is the Roman months of March and April, 30 AD.

Jesus obvious observed his own Sabbaths and Feast times that he and the Father decreed, observing the Passover supper the day before the Jew's observed theirs. As we see, God's Solar year began the day following the Vernal Equinox on the Julian 'Thursday'. The 14th day (God's 2nd Sabbath), was when the supper was to be eaten in the evening of the 2nd Sabbath. Jesus and his disciples observed this, then followed his arrest.

The next morning (the Roman 'Thursday'), he was beaten and crucified on the cross for the next 6 hours. When evening for the Jew's began ~3 pm, the Romans spilled his blood and Jesus gave up the 'ghost'. At this same time the Pharisee priests were spilling the blood of their Passover lambs. Jesus' body was taken down, prepared, and placed in his tomb before sundown. His body was in that tomb for THREE NIGHTS, according to the Jonah prophecy he gave as a SIGN to the Pharisees, (Matthew 12:38-40). He was crucified on God's *day of firstfriuts*. Jesus arose just prior to daylight on the Roman 'Sunday', which was the Jew's *day of firstfruits*, (the 4th day of unleavened bread on the Solar calendar). Then, forty days after his suffering ('passion', Acts 1:3), Jesus levitated up into a cloud. This was the Roman-Julian date **May 14**, 30 AD.

What should a true Christian do concerning the holy days?

"Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the new month, or of the sabbath days: Which are a shadow of things to come; but the body is of Christ." Colossians 2:16-17

Therefore use your own conviction, and avoid judging others. Jesus was faced with the same situation. He quietly observed the true times, and tolerated the Jew's and Roman times, thereby avoiding fruitless debates, of which it was not yet time for those truths to be revealed until he shall restore all things. Note that 'Easter' was substituted in the old German and English version Bibles for the word 'passover'; but Jesus did not arise on the Solar or Jew's Passover! The dictionary meaning of 'Easter' is from "German *Ostern*; orig. name of a goddess and her festival; akin to EAST." (See Exodus 23:13).

Be circumspect, and use this calendar as a research reference and witnessing tool.

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
